

FACULTY OF MEDICINE OF İSTİNYE UNIVERSITY EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENTS

Faculty of Medicine of İstinye University started its education life in İstinye University Topkapı Campus in the 2016-2017 Academic year and continued its pre-clinical phase education on the same campus until the end of the 2022-2023 Academic year. As of the 2023-2024 Academic year, it has moved to the Vadi Central Campus building in the Vadi İstanbul region in order to achieve its goals for education and research, and to offer better classrooms and educational laboratories, larger libraries, free study environments and better social opportunities to increasing numbers of students. Pre-clinical phase training of Faculty of Medicine of İstinye University has started to be held in this building as of the 2023-2024 Academic year.

In addition, our students can get practical training with our faculty members at Liv Ulus and Vadi Istanbul Hospitals, as well.

1) Pre-clinical Education Phase Infrastructure and Facilities

Images of the educational areas used by the Faculty of Medicine in Vadi Central Campus, which has been opened for use since the 2023-2024 Academic year, are shown in Figure 3-17. Used by the Faculty of Medicine in education in Vadi Central Campus; Anatomy Laboratories, Multidisciplinary Application Laboratory, Simulation Center, 3 large classrooms and 4 small study group classrooms are all located on the 1st Floor. There is also access to the top floor of the three-storey library building, located in the center of the Vadi Central Campus building, from the Faculty of Medicine floor. On this floor of the library, there are open and super quiet study areas and three group study areas available to students. In addition to the 1st floor, where most of the educational environments of the ISU Faculty of Medicine are located, there are also three classrooms on the ground floor of the building.

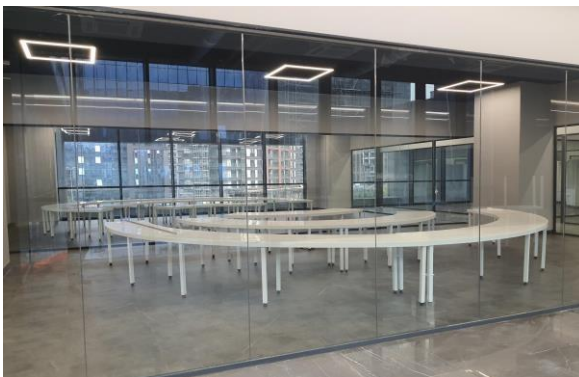
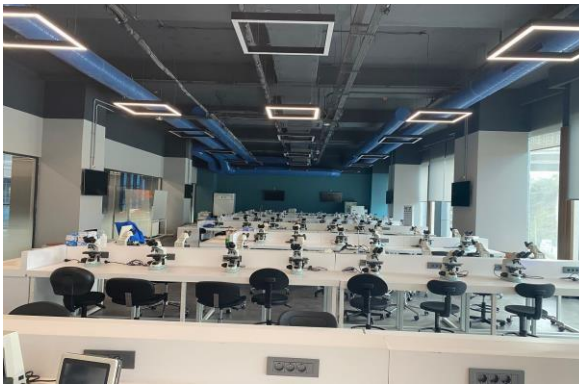


Figure 5. Example images about small group education areas in Vadi Central Campus

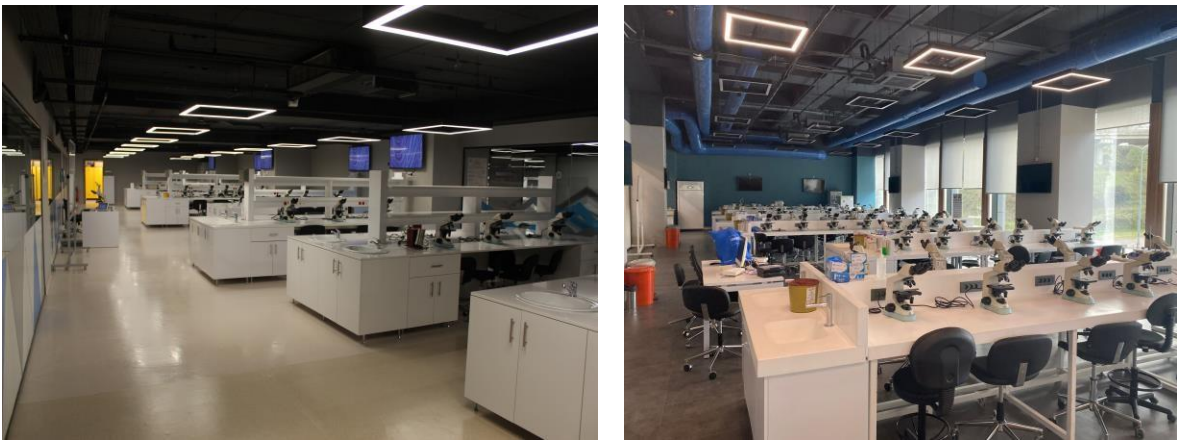


Figure 8. Digital microscopy laboratories

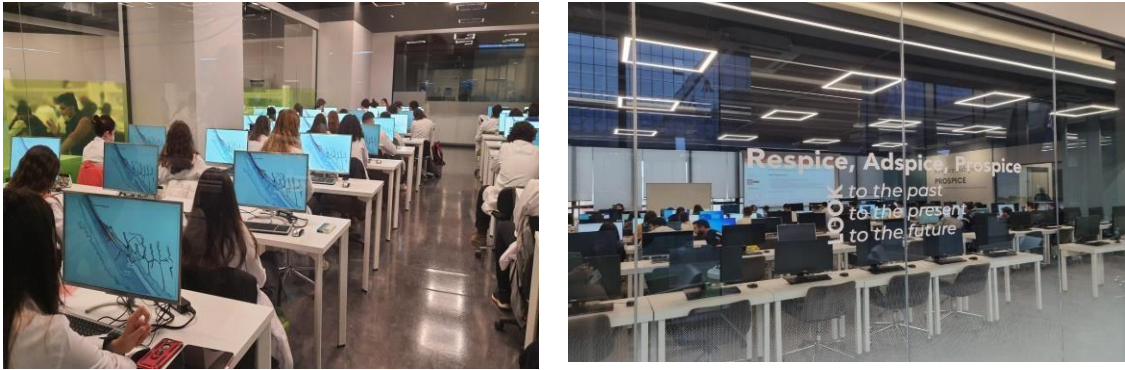


Figure 9. Distance education platform used during and after the pandemic

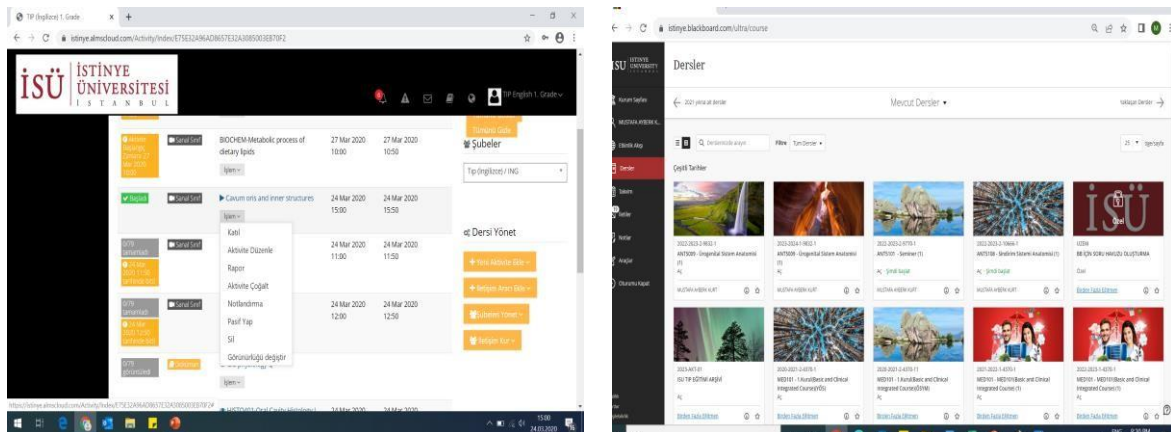


Figure 10. Online digital pathology and histology application screenshots

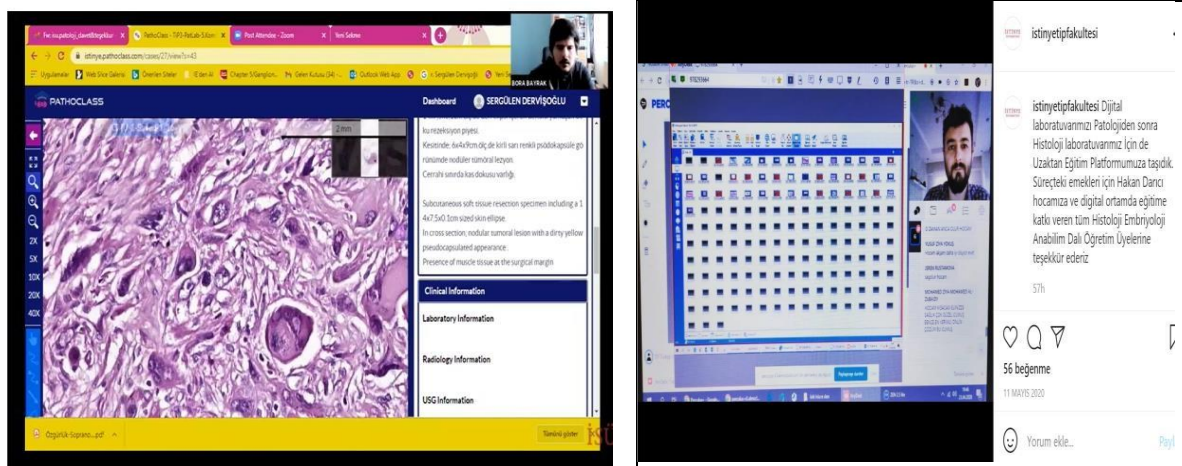


Figure 11. Screen-based virtual laboratory software images developed under the consultancy of our faculty members during the pandemic period

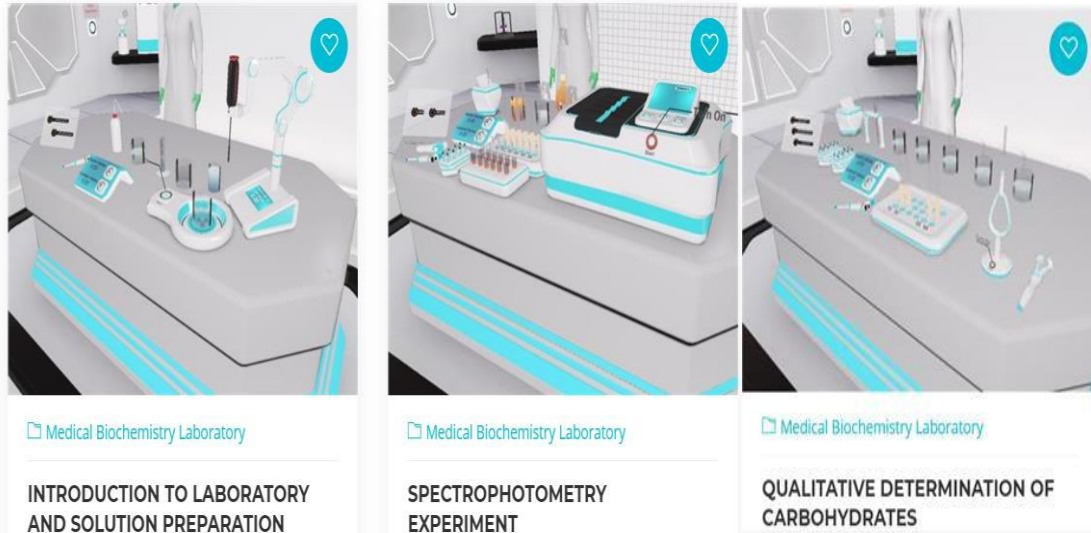


Figure 12. Image of a digital cadaver table used for educational purposes in an anatomy laboratory

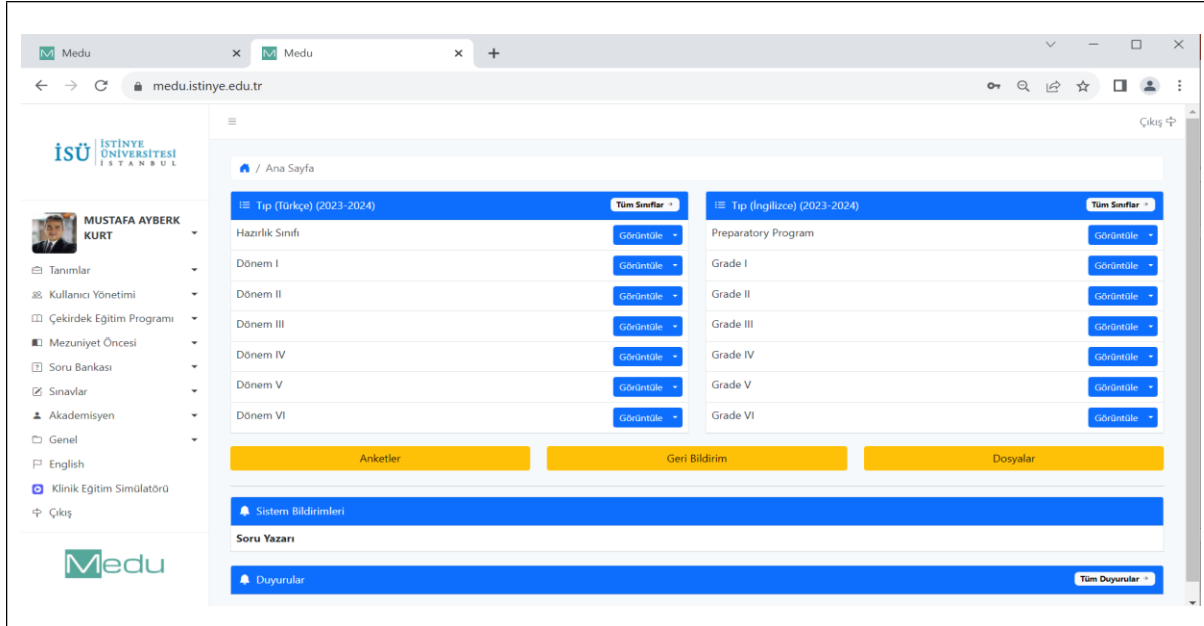


Figure 14. Screenshot of the Screen-based clinical training simulator (SIMULTIMATE) that we use to improve our students' patient management skills

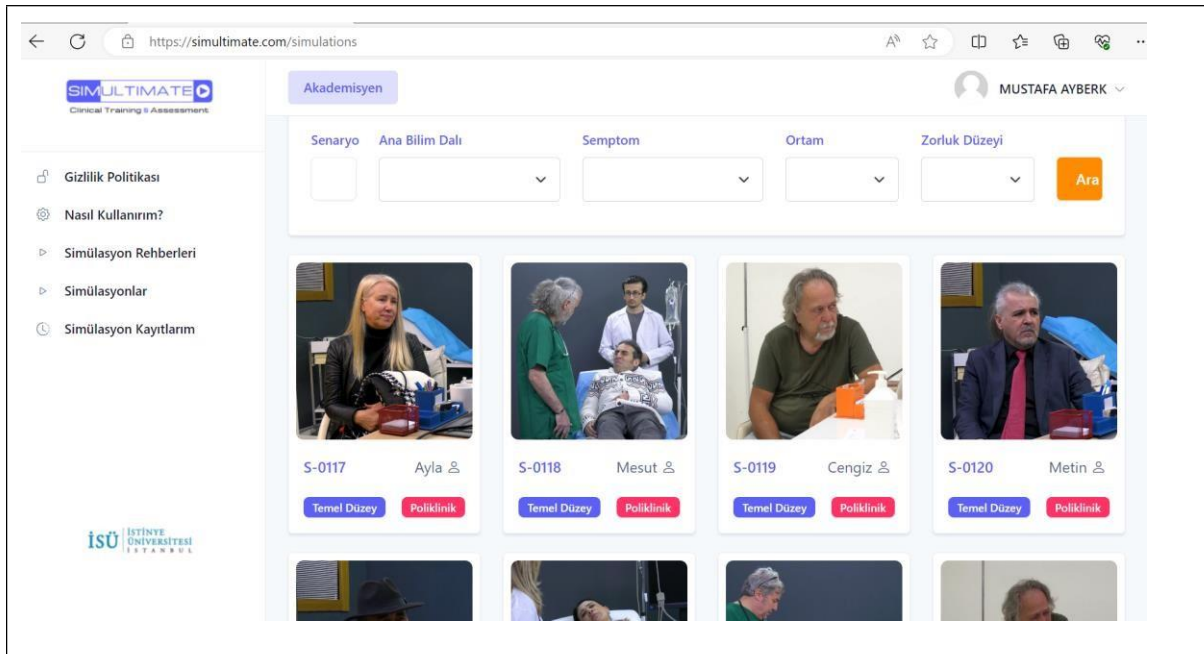


Figure 15. Images of Vadi Central Campus dining hall, cafeteria, lobby and inner courtyard recreation area

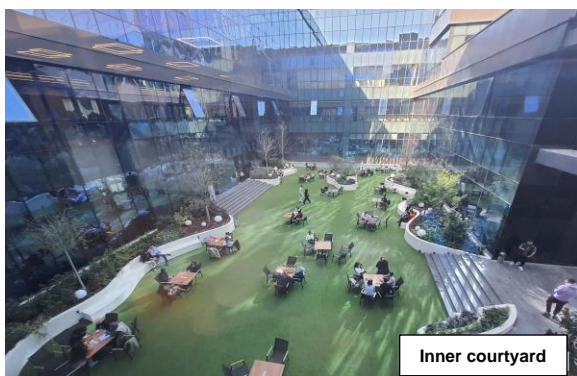
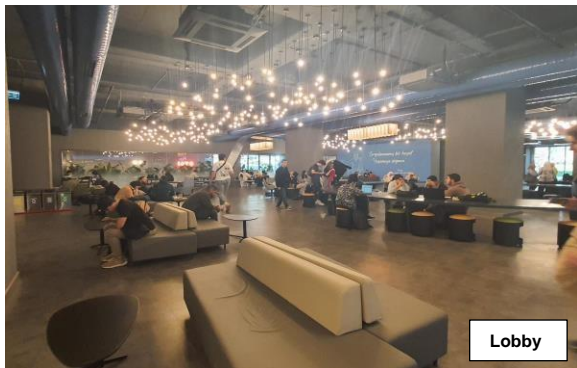
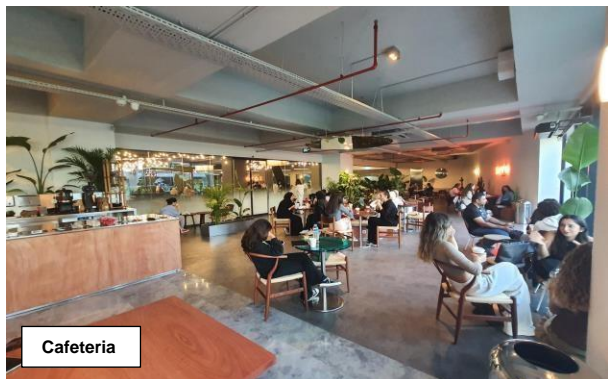
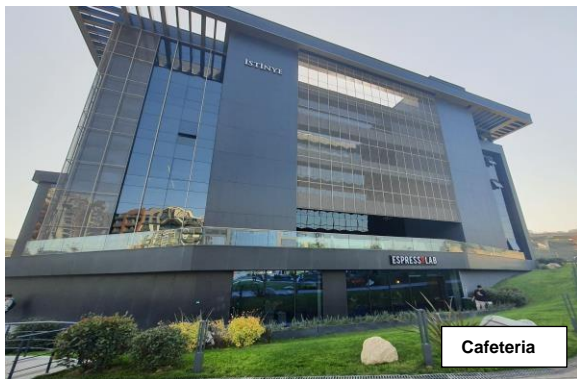
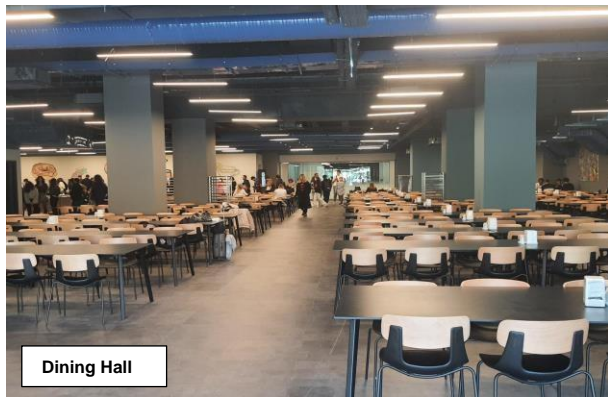
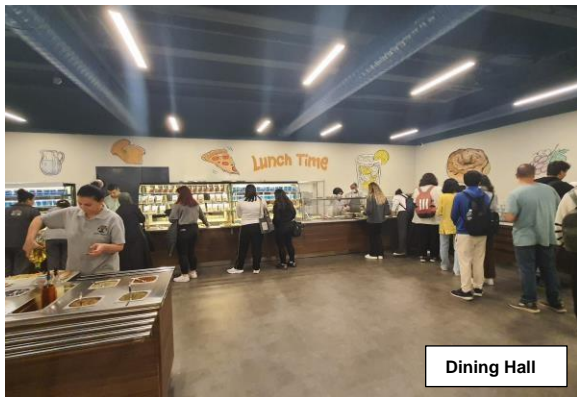


Figure 16. Images of Vadi Central Campus event areas

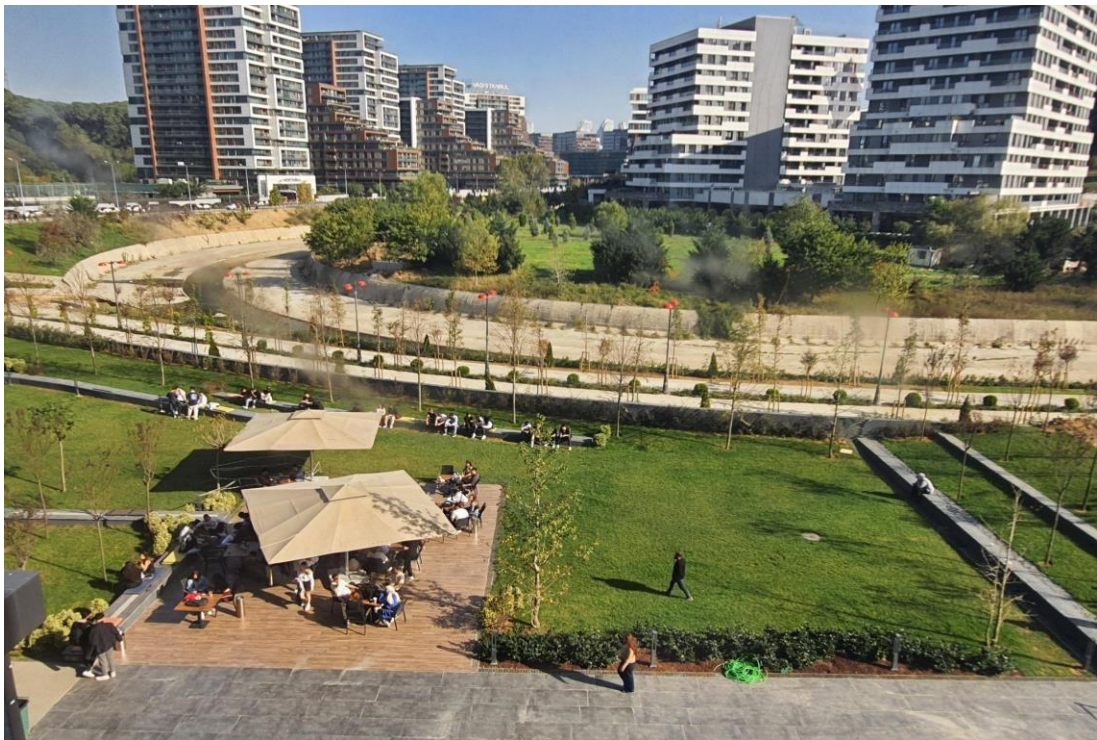
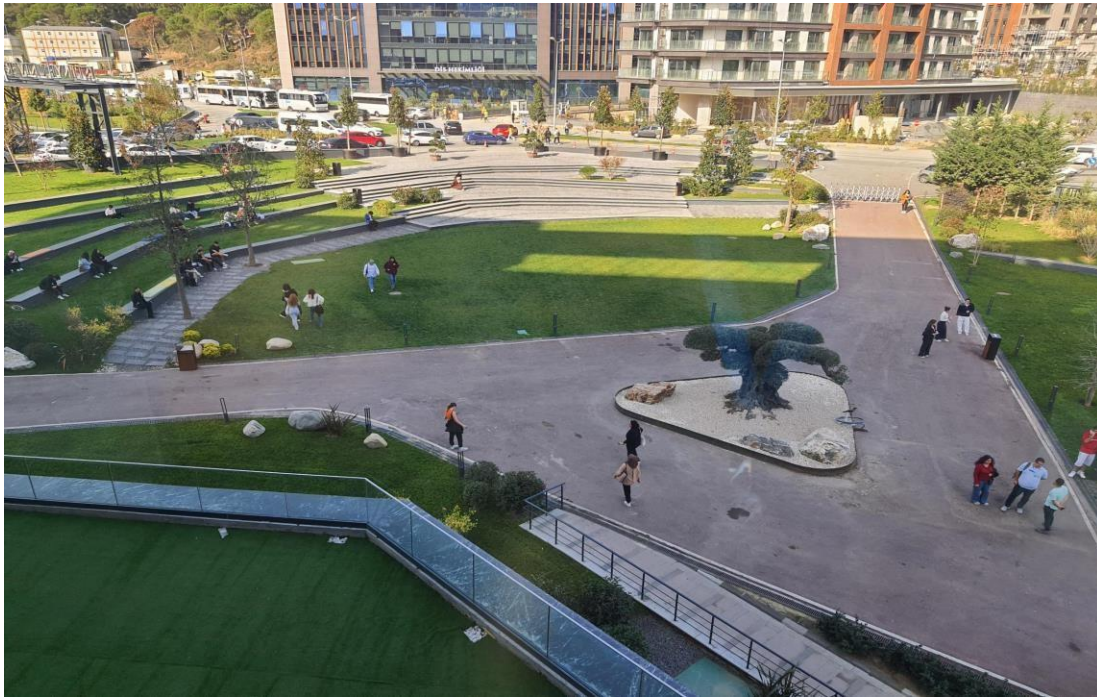
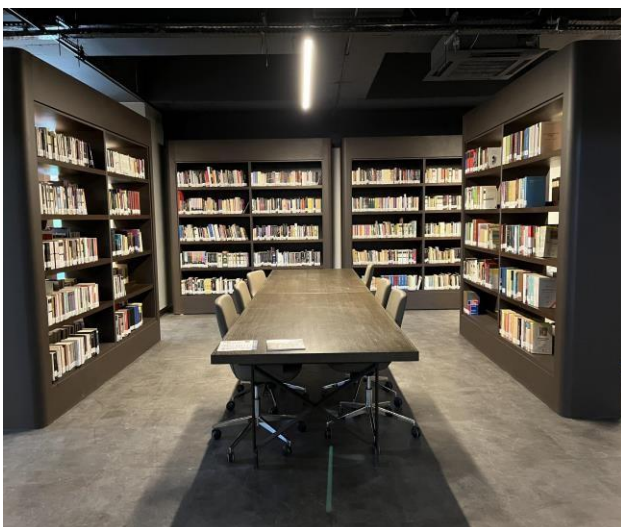


Figure 17. Images of Vadi Central Campus Library



2) Clinical Education Phase Infrastructure and Facilities

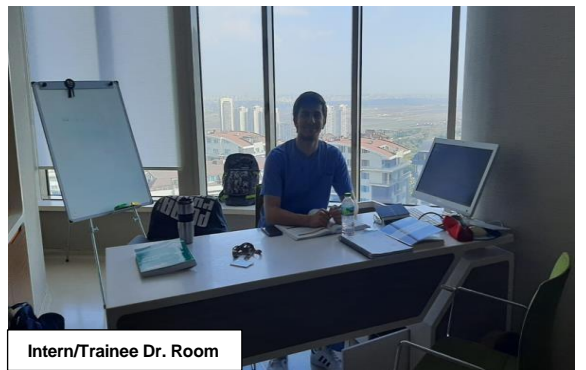
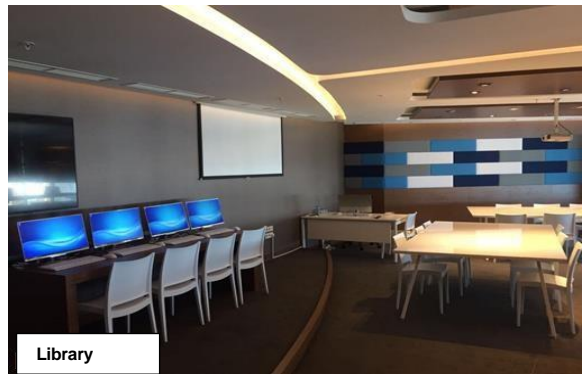
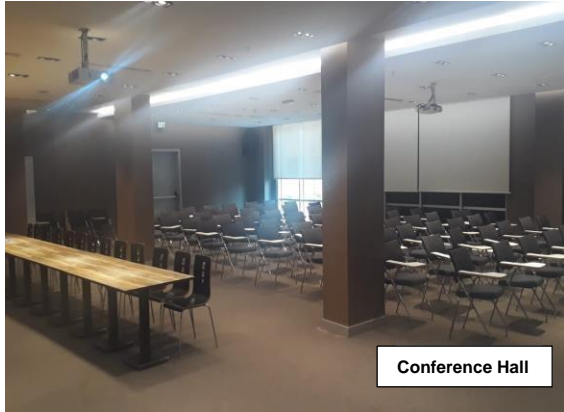


Figure 19. Images of educational environments in Medical Park Hospital Gaziosmanpasa

Istinye University Health Application and Research Center (Liv Hospital Bahcesehir) and Istinye University Health Application and Research Center Additional Service Building (Medical Park Hospital Gaziosmanpasa), where our students carry out most of their applied training during the clinical phase and intern period; has educational environments such as conference halls, classrooms, libraries and guard rooms that can enable education and training activities to be carried out effectively. The conference halls in both hospitals are used for trainings, academic meetings and exams with the participation of faculty members and students. All classrooms have infrastructure equipment such as whiteboard, computer, screen, projector, internet connection and sound system. Information about the educational environments in Health Application and Research Centers is presented in **Table 1**, and images of the said areas are presented in **Figure 18** and **Figure 19**. Furthermore, there are also work and rest areas that intern students can use at Liv Hospital Ulus and Liv Hospital Vadi Istanbul, where students carry out part of their practical training (**Figure 20**).

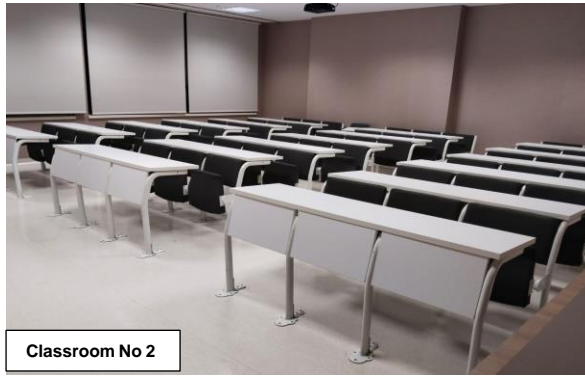

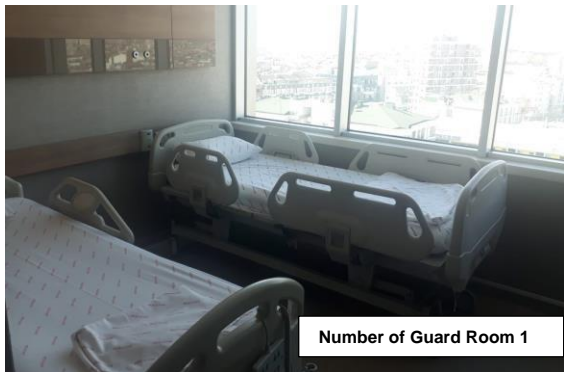
